The Town Board of the Town of Pavilion held a Public Hearing on August 9, 2017 at the Town Hall, One Woodrow Drive, Pavilion, New York 14525 at 6:30 p.m. NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF PAVILION, NEW YORK TO CONSIDER ADOPTING A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that there has been presented to the Town Board of the Town of Pavilion, New York, proposed Local Law No. 1 of 2017 entitled "A Local Law to Amend the Town of Pavilion Zoning Ordinance to Add Criteria for Solar Energy Systems". Said Local Law proposes to amend the Town of Pavilion Zoning Ordinance as summarized as follows: Said Local Law establishes definitions for both commercial and residential solar energy systems and solar farms. The Local Law also requires that all solar energy systems and solar farms obtain a special use permit, a zoning permit and a building permit, and sets design standards for criteria such as height, setbacks, security fencing and signage, with a further provision that the property owner shall remove all obsolete or unused components within 12 months of the end of operations.
